1. Meeting was called to order at 7:40pm
2. Music Program Directors' updates (given by Student President Rebecca Kime)
 - a. DC was amazing; Mr Hughes and the students are very grateful to the CPMC for helping the marching band make the trip.
 - b. Working on the Fall 2017 show "Yes We Can" showcasing Empowerment.
 - c. Band enrollment seems to be around 75-80 instrumentalists and color guard combined. Continue to seek new members!
 - d. Band Camp will be Aug 7-18 with a "show preview" on Friday the 18th (time TBD)
3. Finances
 - a. **Shirley/Dan** - Treasurer's Report; Dawn moved and Carla seconded. Motion approved.
 - b. DC Parade
 - i. Financial report (separate handout); reviewed the income v expenses with attendees. New "profit" is \$565 with a few outstanding reimbursements pending.
 - ii. Decision on how much to "give back" to students; based on the \$7000 that CPMC has used to cover student trip costs, there is no funding available to return to student accounts.
4. Fundraising
 - a. **Diana** – 1st VP report; detailed the upcoming fundraisers (below). Also, Diana would like to have a short FUNdraising meeting following the 7/26 Parent Meet and Greet to delegate some events (with team support)
 - b. Wawa Shorti Coupons – ongoing...fill in order form, turn in to band mailbox and student will be given the coupon vouchers. Already sold out the 1st 150 and ordered another 150. \$1 per voucher goes into student account.
 - c. Car wash – this Saturday, July 22 at Total Rental. Second on August 12 also at Total Rental. Need both AM and PM students/adults; please stay to help cleanup and move out all items
 - d. Canceled Flip-Flop orders – unable to reach the company
 - e. Upcoming –
 - i. Turkey Hill – awaiting approval for August 6th to be held at the Rt 82/340 location
 - ii. Basket Bingo – Sept 10th at Wagontown Fire Hall. Will need lots of assistance for food and basket items. Bingo tickets are \$20 for 20 games. \$5 from each ticket will go in to student account.
 - iii. Krispy Kreme – Orders taken 10/2 thru 10/16 with delivery 10/25 at HS. Shirley will need help dividing orders for pickup.
5. Old Business
 - a. 2016 band show shirts-deadline for shirt size 7/19; order placed 7/20 with Innovations by Design

 - b. Literature stand – after discussion, Sandy moved to order this 12 slot free-standing stand with a cost not to exceed \$300; Shirley seconded. All approved; motion passed.

6. New Business
- a. Parents Meet n Greet – Diana, Gwynne and Dawn will be organizing and reaching out for food donations. Reminder flyers will be given to parents and students at pick on 7/19 and 7/24
 - i. Next Wed., July 26; 6pm in front of band room
 - b. **Band packets and 1st dues payment (\$25) – due today!** They are slowly coming in. Current count ~25 students.
 - c. MAPS Championship scheduled for April 14; will be put on calendar. This is a great honor host the championships as well as good money-maker for the band. We have received high praise on our facilities and personnel; this is a “all hands on deck” event needing 50-60 volunteers
 - d. Band picture day – We will be asking Mr. Hughes to move this event from a school-day afternoon to a Saturday morning for several reason; Middle School students are often unable to attend due to timing and transportation issues, Aug afternoon is very hot in the uniforms, less adults can volunteer in afternoons. Gwynne will connect with Ro Roberts to see if she is available for a Saturday.
 - e. Band Camp – there is a GREAT need for parent volunteers during the 2 weeks of band camp. These adults will be available to assist/attend students who may need to rest (not medical treatment), supply water and Gatorade coolers, chaperone small groups of students around the campus. Half days or full days available. There are 2 parent volunteers to serve as nurse/medical staff. Others would be welcomed!!
 - f. Picnic – Held on Friday, August 18th (time TBD based on show performance). Will need cooks, donated items (will be signup genius), set-up, serving and cleanup. As parents will be invited to watch the preview, it was discussed about including them in the camp meal. One issue is not knowing how many will attend and not over-buying for the event. Considering selling “tickets” to watch the performance and cover adult meal costs---this may allow for a better adult head count.
 - g. Warm-up suits – samples available and students will be measured during band camp. Also - Dinkles, gloves orders will be taken that week. More info will come out as camp approaches.
