Meeting was called to order at 6:43pm

1. Music Program Directors' updates
 - a. Competition schedule – received final approval from Athletic Director and dates/locations will be loaded onto CPMC calendar by end of evening. Nationals needs school board approval. This will reflect the same number of competitions as in past years.
 - b. T-shirt design – hammering out the details of the show and shirt design is based on specifics. Once specifics are finalized, design can be completed. Mr. Hughes doesn't want to include something if it isn't in the show. May use the lights on the Shakos, so that needs to be looked into by Pit Dads.
 - c. Show props – This show won't have elaborate build outs, using our boxes and repurposing them
 - d. Band Camp – is going well for Day 3. Kids should be tired! Sandy stated there are still 2 outstanding band packets—MEDICAL FORM IS CRITICAL to receive. Preview show slated for 4pm on 8/18/17 with picnic to follow.
 - e. Band numbers – 83 students on the field. That puts us in Yankee for COB and Group 4 for US Bands.
2. Finances
 - a. **Shirley/Dan** - Treasurer's Report
 - i. \$16,002.31 account balance; \$606.01 in savings account, \$8,061.93 in Money Market account; \$10,144.09 in 12 mo CD
3. Fundraising
 - a. **Diana** – 1st VP report
 - i. Wawa-ongoing thru year. 500 sold to date. \$1 per coupon goes into student account.
 - ii. Turkey Hill-8/20/17 Sunday; 10a – 2 pm. Rt 82 and 340. Diana has several kids that couldn't make car washes to take with her.
 - iii. Bingo 9/10/17 12-4pm @ Sadsburyville Fire Hall; This will need volunteers to run, shop, cook, man, sell, create baskets. Donations for baskets also needed. Encourage parents to get together to create a "sectional" basket. Baskets need to be valued at \$50 or higher.
 - iv. Car Wash – July 22, August 12. Need for parent help and closer people MUST stay to fully pack up the supplies.
 - v. 31bags – Lisa Last handed out the catalog 1st day of camp; closes shortly after camp. Directions included in handouts.

- e. 2016 band show shirts – available for pick-up during band camp; Lisa also drove around to all Seniors and dropped them off at home.
- f. Literature stand – installed and reminders sent in Smoke Signals that this is in band room for any paperwork needs
- g. Band picture day – Gwynne; Mr Hughes set-up detailed schedule and was sent out to all. Photographer and Gwynne will work on timing to keep everything moving. 2-4pm on 8/25
- h. Picnic – Sandy; 8/18; Parent Preview of show followed by Picnic. Signup Genius has gone out; still need items outstanding. Any parent will be charged \$3 and non band kid 2\$ to help offset the food costs incurred. Band kids are free as it is a budgeted line-item.
- i. Warm-up suits – Sandy; will be fitting during camp and order placed right after. Parents can order as well.
- j. Facebook pages; have been cleaned up, clarified and re-named. The “CPMC group” page is now Red Raider Marching Band. This is for current students, parents, techs, etc. A secondary means of communication, but sharing photos, inspirational quotes, event details etc. (REMIND app will be used in quick/immediate info cases only). The “CPMC like” page is now the Coatesville Music Parents page for community/alum. Will be high-level overview/notification of events, fundraisers, competition dates or scores etc.

5. New Business

- a. Bus snack volunteers – Sandy; 27 people have signed up. They will need to be contacted and specific dates placed throughout the season.
- b. Volunteer sheet – Sandy Exec Board will be contacting those that specifically signed up. It was noted from Color Guard that sewers, pinners, ironers are needed to help create their flags.
